

School Uniform Guide 2025-2026

Dear Parents / Carers,

As we start a brand new academic year – we would like to outline our school uniform expectations for all children at our school.

All children are expected to attend school in school uniform. All Coney Hill branded school uniform can be purchased from the Monkhouse school shop in Gloucester or online www.monkhouse.co.uk. Many high street stores and supermarkets also sell the necessary school uniform items such as skirts, trousers and shirts which can often help to reduce the overall costs for families.

Uniform for all children should include:

- Black, navy or grey trousers or skirt
- Black or grey shorts (weather permitting)
- A blue checked dress (weather permitting)
- Black shoes or black trainers – NO sandals / flip flops or crocs
- A branded Coney Hill jumper / cardigan OR a royal blue equivalent
- A branded Coney Hill white polo shirt OR white polo shirt equivalent
- The 'gold' 100 pride point T-shirts

On P.E & swimming days, we politely ask for children to come to school dressed in their PE kit.

P.E kit for all children should include:

- Black, navy or grey plain shorts, leggings or joggers (weather permitting)
- A pale blue 'branded' PE T-shirt (purchased through Parent Pay) or plain equivalent
- A pale blue 'branded' PE hoodie (available from Monkhouse) or plain equivalent
- OR a plain navy, black or grey hoodie, jumper or jacket for outdoor PE – no logos or motifs
- Alternatively, on colder days, children can wear their school jumper or cardigan with their PE kit.
- Trainers
- NO football shirts
- NO brightly coloured T-shirts / joggers
- NO branded sport tops

We have also noticed that some children are wearing jewellery to school. The only jewellery that is permitted in school are plain stud earrings or jewellery worn on religious grounds. No large hooped earrings. Children will be asked to remove jewellery that is not appropriate. They are allowed to wear a watch. Children are not permitted to wear make-up to school – this is not necessary.

Please ensure that ALL items of school uniform – including coats are clearly named.
Lost property is located in the box in the foyer – please feel free to have a look if your child loses something 😊
